This is with reference to your online application registered on 24/06/2016, on the above subject.

In this connection, I am directed to convey the sanction for extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its Secondary School Examination for a further period of five years w.e.f. 01.04 .2017 to 31.03 .2022 subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

1. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
2. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents by $30^{\text {uh }}$ June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires as per Rule 15.11 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
3. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr.
4. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.

The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State IUT Govt from time to time.
5. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class XII:-

(a) 1.0 acre $1250 \quad 02$ in each class 04 in class $X I$ and $X I I$
(b) 1.5 acre 187503 in each class 04 in class $X 1$ and $X I I$
(d) 2.0 acre $\quad 2500 \quad 04$ in each class $\quad 04$ in class XI and XII
(d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a). (b) and (c) above.
(e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as

7. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
8. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
9. As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.
10. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of "internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
11. The section teacher ratio of $1: 1.5$ is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
12. The schocl and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
3. Income \& Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
14. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Equcation of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose shouid be chis or her collected in the name of the school and the school should naccordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2 \& 3. parents or guardians to any screening procedure iation Bye-Laws, fees charges should be Also, as per Chapter H, Rule No. 11.1 of Affilation.

21. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Govemment/Govt. of India. Further, Salary and Service conditions of staff should be provided in accordance with Rule no. 3.3 (v) and Rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc, prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.
22. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/Statel Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, postal address and e-mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfilment of norms of affliation Bye-Laws and upload the same on the website before 15 th September of every year. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv \& v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, postal address and e-mail, telephone number etc.
23. Continuous sponsoring of students at Board examination is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv), Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.
24. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
25. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defautters.
26. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disablittes Act 1995'.
27. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
28. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
29. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a Health Welliness toacher as per rule 53.5.
30. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.
31. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The contents must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feellings of any chss, community, gender, religious group in society. If prescribed books found having such con ent the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would fif a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duty signed by the ? Manager and the-perncipal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of, the boofs prescettred by thersehool and own the responsibility.

33. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee (Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV).
34. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
35. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of
36. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
37. The schoo' should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XIIXII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
38. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in \& www.cbse.nic.in for updates.
39. In case of established violation of the provisions contained in Affiliation/Examination Bye laws of the Board, the school shall be liable for disaffiliation as per Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.
40. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-
a) The school is required to furnish valid Health \& Sanitary, Safe-Drinking Water, Building Safety and Fire Safety Certificates issued by the competent authorities/concerned department.
b) Schcol is required to procure more books relevant to the academic level of students in the Ebrary and keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
